- Field investigations and outbreak detection
- Disaster epidemiology
- Epidemiologic basis of control and prevention strategies
- Survey methodology
- Data management



# REDI-US Study

- Purpose: to evaluate the effectiveness of an educational program focusing on non-pharmaceutical interventions in reducing influenza-like illness.
